
Project Summary:


The Cheektowaga - Maryvale Schools had not been thoroughly updated since they were originally constructed, and were in need of modernization to serve the district as it entered the 21st century.

Our staff was in charge of coordinating the S.E.D. required Building Conditions Surveys, and performing the Building Program Analysis that led to the District's 5-year Capital Construction Plan. This process assessed over \$80 million in potential improvements to the seven facilities owned by the District, and ultimately guided through the approval of a \$34.7 million Bond Issue Package.

Primary Project Objectives:

- Renovate all classrooms and corridors to facilitate 21st Century program requirements
- New High School Science Wing
- Reconstruct Technology, Music, and Art Classrooms
- New Natatorium Addition
- Building envelope improvements: replace roofs, windows and doors, and masonry restoration
- HVAC System replacement
- New Electrical, data, phone, clock, and fire alarm systems
- Renovate Stadium facility to provide new All-Weather Running Track, Bleachers, scoreboard, and fencing.
