- Renovate all classrooms and corridors to facilitate 21st Century program requirements.
- Provide expanded program spaces for Science, Library, Art, and Home Careers programs

- Expand Cafeteria, and replace food service equipment,
- Replace Heating, Electrical, and Plumbing systems
- Reconfigure site for bus drop off.
- Remove all asbestos and lead.
