
Project Summary:

Work to modernize Ralph Wilson Stadium for the Buffalo Bills and the Erie County Department of Public Works began in 1998 with the \$67. Million project to add suites, and renovate the facility.

Over the years, work has included the renovation of all the existing suites built before 1999 in a 2 year program, design of Ralph Wilson's Office and personal suites, and the design of a 280 person suite for the Seneca Niagara Casino.


